

Kings International College Examinations Results 2018

This summer saw a significant increase in the number of subjects being assessed on the 9-1 scale. This to better differentiate between the highest performing students and to distinguish clearly between the old and new exams. Grade 9 is the highest grade.

The old and new GCSE grading scales do not directly compare but there are three points where they align:

- The bottom of grade 7 is aligned with the bottom of the old grade A;
- The bottom of grade 4 is aligned with the bottom of the old grade C; and
- The bottom of grade 1 is aligned with the bottom of the old grade G.

At Kings we are extremely proud of our pupils' achievements and the hard work and support provided by our staff. These results mean that each of our pupils leave us with a full range of options, providing them genuine choice when deciding on their future education or training.

Other Subjects

- Four subjects achieved 100% 9-4, including Biology, Dance, Spanish and Sports Science. An additional three subjects achieved 90%+ 9-4, including Chemistry, Drama and Physics.

EBacc

- The % of pupils achieving the EBacc at a 4+ was 7%, with 5% of pupils achieving a grade 5 or above.

Pupil Highlights

- 100% of pupils attending Kings achieved at least 1x 9-1 qualification. This is particularly pleasing because we are a comprehensive school taking the full range of ability and it shows that the curriculum is sufficiently broad and flexible so that all pupils can gain a 9-1 grade in at least one subject.
- 20% of pupils achieved eight or more grades 9-7; 12% of pupils achieved five or more grades 9-7. This demonstrates that at Kings we challenge all pupils of all abilities, raising and sustaining the aspirations of all young people.

We believe that a number of factors have contributed to these successes: hard work from our pupils, the support of our parents and the skill and dedication of our teachers and support staff.
