Safeguarding Wave Provision



WAVE 3&4 – Specialist Provision

Is specific interventions for young people and their families, identified as requiring additional support.

Referrals made to Surrey/Hampshire Children's Single Point of Access (CSPA, Police, Mindworks (*neurodevelopment and mental health needs*)). Children's Services include Child Protection, Child in Need and Early Help Support which is a level of interventions involving a multi-agency approach

WAVE 2 – School targeted support

Time-limited provision, identified as 1:1 support or small group interventions. Support from analysis of disclosures and/or teacher/parent/child identification.

1:1 support Staff Pastoral Support includes Heads of Year, ELSA and SEN intervention, Student Welfare Officer, Short Stay School projects, ELSA,

1:1 support with Agencies – CYFC, EIKON, WEY VALLEY, EAST2WEST, SCHOOL NURSE, NHS MENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONERS

WAVE 1 – All stakeholders provision

Universal offer for all students.

Year 6 transition meetings with schools, parents and the young person to share any relevant information

Student personal development days and PSHE lessons – topics, Health, Wellbeing and Relationships, the Wider world, Citizenship, Safeguarding training to students that relate to Keeping Children Safe in Education, Assemblies, School Nurse Drop in sessions, Pastoral Care.
