Wave 3 Provision
(Personalised)

Is specific, targeted interventions for students who are identified as requiring additional support. This will involve provisions such as:

Sharing safeguarding concerns through Surrey Children's Single Point of Access (or Hampshire) / Referring concerns via SPA and police / Child Protection meetings / Team around the Family Meetings / Family Support / Child in Need Meetings.

All the above usually encompassed within: L2 Early Help / L3 Targeted Help / L4 Specialist Help

Wave 2 Provision (Targeted)

Is additional, time-limited provision, normally in the form of 1:1 sessions or small-group interventions. Wave 2 provisions are put in place following careful analysis of disclosure trends and/or teacher/parent identification. This provision includes:

1:1 welfare meetings including 1:1 personalised education programs / ELSA and CBT referrals / KISP referrals (Surrey Police project) / 1:1 behaviour support / Managed moves / Short stay school projects / PSP wok / Youth Worker support via Camberley Youth for Christ / In house behaviour support sessions / In house SEN intervention support / School nurse referrals / use of ILC

Wave 1 Provision (All Stakeholders)

Is the provision that is universal offer for all students. The majority of students needs will be met through this provision. This provision includes:

Tutorial Safeguarding Hot Topics / Transition meetings with parents, students in Y6 and then Y7 / DSL meetings with feeder school DSLs during transition period / PD day topics - SexEd,Crime,Druge,Citz days / Lesson curriculum - PSHCE / PE / ICT /Science / Y7 transition safeguarding assembly / School Nurse drop ins / Pastoral care - wrap around monitoring and support for all students / CPOMS tool to ensure that all staff are able to share safeguarding concerns quickly and confidentially to the safeguard team
