

Kings International College Examinations Results 2023

A huge congratulations to our students on their achievements this summer. They have overcome many barriers on the way to the 2023 examinations and we are immensely proud of their commitment and determination to succeed. We also thank the dedicated staff that supported Year 11 in achieving these results.

We wish every one of our 2023 leavers the very best in the next part of their lives.



In total, 32 of our students achieved a grade 8 or a grade 9 in one or more of their GCSEs. An even bigger number – 50, achieved a grade 7 or above across their various subjects and so a massive well done on this amazing feat.



Every child was entered into English and Maths GCSE, with 76% achieving a grade 4 or above in English, and 65% achieving a grade 4 or above in Maths. In the key measure of achieving a grade 4 or a grade 5 or above in both English & Maths GCSE, Kings students have achieved 62% at a grade 4 or above, and 40% at a grade 5 or above. Significantly, these results will enable our learners to study the post-16 course of their choice.

It has been widely publicised that 2023 results would be lower compared to 2022 results, with the aim of bringing the national picture in line with 2019 GCSE outcomes. Nationally, across all subjects, the % of grades 4 and above have fallen compared to last year. Kings however is proud to report that in 13 of our subjects the % of students achieving a grade 4 or above is either at the same level e.g. Biology: 100% in both 2022 and 2023; or has increased e.g. Business Studies 54% grade 4+ in 2022, 71% grade 4+ in 2023.

Other subject headlines include 100% of pupils achieving a grade 4 or above in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Spanish. In addition, 83% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in German and 76% achieved a grade 4 or above in Religious Studies.
